Morocco Tour Arrival & Departure Information Sheet

Arriving

- If you are arriving at the *Fez-Saiss* or *Marrakech Menara* Airports, take a white, Mercedes taxi just outside the airport to Bab Guissa (*Geessa*) in Fez or Hotel Tazi in Marrakesh. This should cost between 120-150 dirhams. Agree on the price before you get into the taxi. If you are arriving late, we can arrange this for you.
- If you are flying into *Mohammed V* Airport in Casablanca and want to head directly to Fez, Rabat or Marrakesh, there are trains located on the lower level of the airport. You will need to change trains in Casablanca at the station called "*Casa Voyageurs*". We will meet you at either train station.

Casablanca Airport to Casa Voyageurs (30 min's): every hour (last train at 23:50)

Casa Voyageurs to Fez (4.5 hrs): every 2 hours (last train at 22:00)

Casa Voyageurs to Marrakech (3.5 hrs): every 2hours (last train at 21:45)

Depart	Arrive	1 st Class	2 nd Class

Casa Voyageurs to Rabat Ville (1 hr): every 1-2 hours (last train at 22:30)

Depart	Arrive	1 st Class	2 nd Class

*Keep your train ticket with you until you leave the train station of arrival.

**To ask for one, one-way ticket to Casa Voyageurs /Fez /Rabat/Marrakesh. First/Second class in French:

«Un aller simple à Casa Voyageurs/Fes/Rabat/Marrakech. Première/Deuxième classe.»

(Uhn ahlay sempluh ah Kaza Voyahjer/Fez /Rahbah/Mrraksh. Pruhmeeyer/Duhzeeyem class.)

- If you need Moroccan currency (dirhams), both airports have bank booths and ATMs. You will also be able to exchange money in the major cities, such as Rabat, Fez, Ifrane, Essaouira or Marrakesh. This will be harder in smaller towns and villages, unless you will be taking out funds with a credit or debit card from ATM machines. **DO NOT BRING TRAVELER'S CHECKS.**
- If you want to stay in Casablanca before beginning the tour, you can take a train from the airport to downtown Casablanca. Just outside the train station "*Casa Voyageurs*", you can take a small, red taxi (no more than 25 dirhams) to a hotel. Most of the hotels are located in this area. Then, to get to Fez, Rabat or Marrakesh, there are daily trains that leave regularly from "*Casa Voyageurs*" –see times above.

Hotels in Casablanca – all with private bathroom and shower. Prices listed in Moroccan dirhams.

Hôtel Astrid – 12, Rue 6 Novembre (022 27 78 03); Single 320 / Double 378; Brkfst 33

Hôtel Noailles – 22, Blvd du 11 Janvier (022 20 25 54); Single 250 / Double 300; Brkfst 27

Leaving

- If you are flying out of *Marrakech Menara* Airport, we will help you arrange transportation there.
- If you are flying out of *Mohammed V* Airport in Casablanca, there are daily trains that leave regularly from Marrakesh. In Casablanca, change trains at "*Casa Voyageurs*".

Marrakech to Casa Voyageurs (3.5 hrs): every 2 hours (last train at 21:00)

Casa Voyageurs to Casablanca Airport (30 min's): every hour (last train at 22:05)

Depart	Arrive	1 st Class	2 nd Class
05:05	05:35	50 dirhams	35 dirhams

- You can exchange your Moroccan dirhams into whatever hard currency you'd like your last day in Marrakesh. This won't be possible at the airport in Casablanca.
