

VISA information for Morocco

Citizens of **Egypt, Palestine, Jordan** and **Lebanon** will need to apply for visas, according to the Morocco visa website.

Please note that Citizens of the following countries **do not need a visa** to enter the Kingdom of Morocco and may stay up to 90 days (If your stay is longer than 90 days, a resident permit is required and can be issued by the Police Department of your place of residence in Morocco):

Algeria - Andorra - Argentina - Australia – Austria – Bahrain – Belgium – Brazil – Bulgaria - Canada – Chile – Congo Popular Republic – Croatia - Cyprus - Czech Republic - Denmark – Estonia - Finland – France - Germany – Great Britain – Greece – Guinea (Conakry) - Hongkong - Hungary – Iceland – Indonesia – Ireland – Italy – Ivory Coast – Japan – Kuwait – Latvia - Libya – Liechtenstein – Lithuania - Luxemburg – Mali – Malta – Mexico - Monaco – Netherlands – New Zealand – Niger – Norway – Oman – Peru – Philippines – Poland - Puerto Rico – Qatar – Russian Federation - Saudi Arabia – Senegal – Singapore (They can stay one month without visa) – Slovakia - Slovenia - South Korea – Spain – Sweden – Switzerland – Tunisia – Turkey – United Arab Emirates – United States of America - Venezuela.

Citizens from countries not listed above do need a visa and may apply according to the following instructions:

1. All items must be completed on the front and reverse of the application form.
2. Mail your completed form attention: "Visa Department" with the following:
 - Your original valid passport (minimum validity of 6 months at the entry date).
 - One passport size color photo (Would you please write your full name on the back of the pictures).
 - Copy of your legal status in the US: Green card, F1 Visa, or Work permit.
 - Copy of your detailed flight itinerary and/or copy of the ticket in case of purchase.

Citizens from countries not listed above do need a visa and may apply according to the following instructions:

3. All items must be completed on the front and reverse of the application form.
4. Mail your completed form attention: "Visa Department" with the following:
 - Your original valid passport (minimum validity of 6 months at the entry date).
 - One passport size color photo (Would you please write your full name on the back of the pictures).
 - Copy of your legal status in the US: Green card, F1 Visa, or Work permit.
 - Copy of your detailed flight itinerary and/or copy of the ticket in case of purchase.
 - Employment verification from your employer in the US.
 - Notarized Letter of Invitation from your sponsor in Morocco or hotel reservation.
 - A self addressed Express Mail envelope for passport return (Express-mail is the only form of mailing accepted).
5. Fees:
 - 24 hours: \$12
 - 48 hours: \$15
 - 3 to 90 days (one entry): \$27
 - 3 to 90 days (2 entries): \$38
6. Mailing your passport: If you have to mail your passport, avoid using regular mail. Please use US express mail.
7. Method of payment: Please be advised that the consulate does not accept personal checks. ONLY money orders, company checks, or

cash (if applying in person) may be accepted as forms of payment. Please do not send cash in the mail.

8. Processing your application: Your application will be processed ONLY if you provide information to all items on the form as prescribed by the above guidelines. The processing time is no less than three days.

*Residents of countries other than the US, must contact the nearest Moroccan Consulate or embassy of country of residence, New York Office processes applications for US residents or students only. If you need assistance, you are kindly requested to contact this office PRIOR to mailing your package, Business hours: M-th.: 10.00 AM to 2.00 PM/ Friday: 10.00 AM to 1.00. Note: Visa Issuance will be carried out at the sole discretion of the Consulate General.
